FINAL ASSIGNMENT

(English-speaking course only)

REQUIREMENTS:

Write an essay on one of the following topics (of your choice). Apply a critical thinking framework: present facts, express your opinion supported by proper, substantive argumentation. Refer to any other opinions and comment them.

TOPIC 1: The Crisis of Democracy in the 21st Century.

Do you think democracy is the right system of government? Is it experiencing a crisis? Are there different versions of democracy (liberal, non-liberal, etc.)? What should determine the assessment of the 'right' state system: economic efficiency, people's satisfaction, individual freedom, society rights?

TOPIC 2: Who am I?

Try to look at yourself in the context of what defines you. What are the most important components of your identity? Faith? Origin? Gender? Political views? Sexual identity? Life role? Profession? What are the foundations of your perception of yourself in the world and the place you occupy in it."

SIZE AND SCOPE:

The essay has no requirements of length (insight matters, not the word count), but I personally think 3 pages are the minimum. I would appreciate the essays written from your perspective, with real thoughts and written 'from the deepest heart'. Do not rewrite Wiki (or GPT chat) – it is your personal opinion I do value!

DELIVERY AND DEADLINE:

The text should be sent as PDF or DOC file, attached to a mail. Please make sure that author's name (that is: yours) is in the text.

Please use "CIVITAS CRITICAL THINKING" as a subject of the email. Please specify your name in the email text, too.
